Just as God has blessed us with the variety of the four seasons, so He blesses our lives with changes in the seasons of life and ministry. Some changes are coming to the seminary here, especially in light of our last conversation with the seller of the El Real property.

The Uruguayan Summer

We are so glad to be nearing the end of the summer here! The Uruguayan sun is very hot, and prolonged exposure to it can be dangerous. A few of us learned that first hand upon getting sick after a full weekend of ministry in late January. Though we were weak, God demonstrated Himself strong as we baptized a number of new converts in the river. This month, we also participated in the children's and teen camps of our church. Micki gave a missionary story at children's camp about Robert Moffat, while I taught two parables from Matthew 13. Micki helped in the kitchen during youth camp and is quickly gaining a reputation for her culinary expertise! She introduced corn dogs to Uruguay, and the teens love her for it!

Seminary Season

Our first night of seminary classes will be on Friday, March 11. We will be introducing many new classes, including *The Book of Acts*, *The History and Philosophy of the Baptist Distinctives*, *Evangelism*, *The Doctrine of Creation*, and *Modern Religions*. I have spent the past few weeks preparing video summaries on YouTube of the Greek curriculum I wrote last year. I am praying that in the next few years these videos, along with our online class, will help Spanish-speaking Bible students everywhere get a better grip on the original language of God's Word and attract them to our seminary.

El Real Purchase

Early this week, Archie Perez and I met with the seller of the property. We have agreed upon a purchase, and our *escribana* (realtor/lawyer) and that of the seller are formalizing the agreement to ensure we will not be deceived or cheated.
