The Term "Seminary"

We changed the name of the institute here to "seminary" (*El Seminario Bautista de Colonia*), because unlike most local "institutes," we are inviting people nationally and internationally to come and study with us. Our purpose is to disseminate, cultivate and defend the good seed of the Word in a local church context and train faithful people to do the same (2 Timothy 2:2). We also offer more in-depth Greek training, something that has characterized seminaries historically.

15+ Countries

Many of you watched the YouTube introduction to our online Greek course, entitled ¿Por Qué Estudiar Griego Bíblico? ("Why Study Biblical Greek?"). Most of the lesson summaries are now available online, and I have been excited to see interest in these and our other videos grow steadily. We have already reached into more than 15 Spanish speaking countries, with the top hits being in Uruguay (1,081 minutes watched), Argentina (397), Colombia (387), Spain (362), Mexico (296), Peru (284), and Ecuador (157). I am praying that the videos will encourage theological literacy everywhere and help promote our seminary.

We continue to pray for the completion of the *El Real* property purchase so we can begin cleaning and repairs. Pastor Gabriel is more than a little excited to begin church meetings there!
